February Sanitarian's Report:

A&P salad sampling was discussed. Ms. Quinn stated that it is not a state law anymore to test salads – it is the stores decision.

Johns Famous Bagels has had numerous violations but all is good at this time.

Regarding the Hilton a complaint was received reporting mold in a building not open to the public. Ms. Quinn will inspect this site in the spring with Nick Saluzzi, the Construction Code Official.

The Sanitarian's Report was accepted on a motion from Dr. Sperber, seconded by Mr. Frey and carried by all.

February Water Reports:

Mr. Frey noticed that sodium was high and called Mr. Beattie at Park Ridge Water who assured him it was not at a dangerous level and that well water is not effected by road salt as are surface water systems.

These reports were accepted on a motion from Ms. Micali, seconded by Mr. Frey and carried.

County Health Reports:

A motion to accept these reports was made by Ms. Micali, seconded by Dr. Sperber, and carried.

Spring Newsletter:

All members were in favor of the Board of Health spring newsletter submission.

Discussion: 100% Smoke Free- Councilman Rendo presented the sample ordinance and recommended that it be passed at the last Council meeting. The Council has agreed and has instructed the Borough Attorney to draft the ordinance for introduction at the April 7th meeting of the Council.

The meeting was adjourned on a motion from Dr. Sperber, seconded by Mr. Frey, and carried. Time being 8:10 p.m.
