Sanitarian's Report

December, January, February's reports were discussed. The report was accepted on a motion by Dr. LaPaglia, seconded by Josephine Higgins, and carried.

Miscellaneous Discussion

Elaine Metlitz would like information that discusses the disposal of medical waste in households. Linda Quinn will forward this information to her.

Elaine also discussed the increase in dog bites and Linda explained it may be due to the holidays and family's visiting with their pets. All dog bites are reported to the county and they determine if the dog is potentially dangerous. Checking on dog ordinance to see if it needs updating. The Hilton Spa failed bacteria test. It will be closed, emptied and refilled. Linda Quinn will re-check it before its reopened.

All food licenses were renewed for 2015.

Panera Bread is renovating the restaurant, all work is after business hours.

Discussion between board members about refrigerator temperature and the handling and preparation of foods.

County Report

A vote was taken regarding the flu vaccine that occurs in November 2015. After extensive discussion the board decided to withdraw from the county giving the vaccine. The flu clinic had a low number of residents who received the vaccine, leaving the Borough with a large amount of vaccines that were not used. The Board felt the vaccine is readily available in Woodcliff Lake, Montvale and Park Ridge at CVS, A&P, Pharmacy's and Doctor's Offices.
