Resolution Authorizing Award of Contract for Pascack Valley Cooperative Pricing System (#107-PVCPS) – Award for D&L Paving to Perform Work in Woodcliff Lake as Outlined in Master Contract 2012 NJDOT Project (Campbell Avenue) **(Consent Agenda – 8)**

WHEREAS, on February 26, 2013, the Borough of Westwood, acting as Lead Agency for the Pascack Valley Cooperative Pricing System (#107-PVCPS), received bids for the 2012 NJDOT Project; and

WHEREAS, five (5) bids were received for four municipalities, with totals ranging from \$456,581.36 to \$543,204.40; and

WHEREAS, the bids were reviewed by Azzolina and Feury Engineering, Inc. on behalf of the Pascack Valley Cooperative Pricing Program; and

WHEREAS, Azzolina & Feury Engineering has summarized the bid prices and recommends the award of contract to D&L Paving Contractors, Inc., in the amount of \$456,581.36; and

Resolution to Adopt the Provisions of Chapter 48 (N.J.S.A. 52:14.17.38) (Consent Agenda – 12)

A **RESOLUTION** to adopt the provisions of Chapter 48 (N.J.S.A. 52:14.17.38) under which a public employer may agree to pay for State Health Benefits (SHBP) and/or School Employees' Health Benefits Program (SEHBP) coverage of certain retirees.

BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the Borough of Woodcliff Lake hereby elects to adopt the provisions of N.J.S.A. 52:14-17.38 and adhere to the rules and regulations promulgated by the State Health Benefits Commission and School Employees' Health Benefits Commission to implement the provisions of that law.
2. This resolution affects employees as shown the attached Chapter 48 Resolution Addendum. It is effective on the 1st day of April, 2013.
3. We are aware that adoption of this resolution does not free us of the obligation to pay for post-retirement medical benefits of retirees or employees who qualified for those payments under any Chapter 88 Resolution or Chapter 48 Resolution adopted previously by this governing body.
4. We agree that this Resolution will remain in effect until properly amended or revoked with the SHBP and/or SEHBP. We recognize that, while remain in the SHBP and/or SEHBP, we are responsible for providing the payment for post-retirement medical coverage as listed in the attached Chapter 48 Resolution Addendum for all employees who qualify for this coverage while this Resolution is in force.
5. We understand that we are required to provide the Division of Pensions and Benefits complete copies of all contracts, ordinances, and resolutions that detail post-retirement medical payment obligations we undertake. We also recognize that we may be required to provide the Division with information needed to carry out the terms of this Resolution.

BOND ORDINANCE STATEMENT AND SUMMARY

The bond ordinance, the summary terms of which are included herein, has been finally adopted by the Borough Council of the Borough of Woodcliff Lake, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, on April 1, 2013, and the 20-day period of limitation within which a suit, action or proceeding questioning the validity of such ordinance can be commenced, as provided in the Local Bond Law, has begun to run from the date of the first publication of this statement. Copies of the full ordinance are available, at no cost and during regular business hours, at the Clerk's office for members of the general public who request the same. The summary of the terms of such bond ordinance follows:

Title: BOND ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE MAKING OF VARIOUS PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS AND THE ACQUISITION OF NEW ADDITIONAL OR REPLACEMENT EQUIPMENT AND MACHINERY, NEW INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY EQUIPMENT AND A NEW AUTOMOTIVE VEHICLE, INCLUDING ORIGINAL APPARATUS AND EQUIPMENT, IN, BY AND FOR THE BOROUGH OF WOODCLIFF LAKE, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF \$1,570,000 TO PAY THE COST THEREOF, TO MAKE A DOWN PAYMENT, TO APPROPRIATE BOROUGH TRUST FUNDS, TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS TO FINANCE SUCH APPROPRIATION AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES IN ANTICIPATION OF THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH BONDS.

The purposes, appropriations and bonds/notes authorized in this multipurpose bond ordinance are as follows:

SCHEDULE OF IMPROVEMENTS, PURPOSES AND AMOUNTS

A. Undertaking of (i) drainage improvements at Brookview Drive and (ii) the 2013 Road Improvement Program at various locations, as set forth on a list prepared by the Borough Engineer on file or to be placed on file with the Borough Clerk, and hereby approved as if set forth herein in full. Depending upon the contract price and other exigent circumstances, and upon approval by the Borough Council, there may be additions to or deletions from the list referred to in clause (ii) of the preceding sentence. It is hereby determined and stated that said roads being improved are of "Class B" or equivalent construction as defined in Section 22 of the Local Bond Law (Chapter 2 of Title 40A of the New Jersey Statutes Annotated, as amended; the "Local Bond Law").
