Next we went to Lou Costello Park where, after hearing a history of the park, were entertained by Abbott and Costello impersonators.

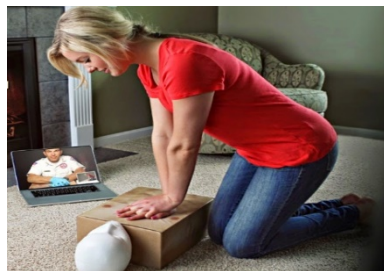

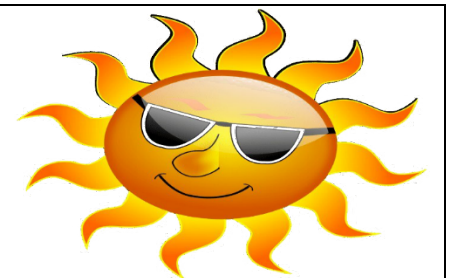
