- B. These funds shall be used for the purchase of open space so as to preserve such land as open space, and to keep said land in its natural state.
- C. If no open space is available for purchase, then the monies in said fund shall be used for such other passive recreation, conservation, farmland preservation or historic preservation purposes as may be permitted by law, to be determined following a public hearing.
- D. Open Space Trust Fund monies may also be used to pay debt service on indebtedness issued or incurred by the Borough for the purposes set forth in Section B and C above.

INTERPRETATIVE STATEMENT

This binding referendum will give the elected officials of Woodcliff Lake the sentiment of the voters concerning the continuation of Woodcliff Lake's Open Space Trust Fund. This Trust Fund was established in accord with the public's sentiment to authorize the acquisition of real property for open space purposes. The Borough Council will determine the yearly rate, which would be \$0.01 (one cent) for each one hundred (\$100) dollars of real property assessment. Therefore, as an example, the owner of a house assessed at \$767,962.00 (the average assessment of a home in the Borough) would pay a yearly open space tax that will not exceed \$77.00 each year. An affirmative vote would allow the Borough to continue to collect this special levy for a period of seven (7) years, at which time the Governing Body would again submit a proposition for public referendum. If open space is not available for purchase, the monies in the Fund would be used for such other passive recreation, conservation, farmland preservation or historic preservation purposes as may be permitted by law, to be determined following a public hearing. Open space monies may also be used to pay debt service on Borough indebtedness incurred for any of the authorized purposes.
