RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING GRANT APPLICATION FOR NEW JERSEY HISTORIC TRUST PRESERVE, PRESERVE NEW JERSEY HISTORIC PRESERVATION FUND 2019 CAPITAL LEVEL I GRANT PROGRAM

RESOLUTION NO. 19-114 APRIL 15, 2019

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Woodcliff Lake desires to further historic preservation by obtaining a grant from the New Jersey Historic Trust, Preserve New Jersey Historic Preservation Fund, 2019 Capital Level I Grant Program in the amount of \$89,730 to complete historic landscaping at the Westervelt–Lydecker House located at Werimus and Old Mill Rds., Woodcliff Lake, New Jersey listed on the New Jersey and National Registers of Historic Places, for a total project cost of \$149,550.

WHEREAS, the Preserve New Jersey Historic Preservation Fund, 2019 Capital Level I Grant Program allow a grantee to request a total of 60% matching funds, which requires a grantee financial match of \$2 for every \$3 received;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Borough Council authorizes the Mayor to: sign the appropriate assurances and acknowledge the certification above; if awarded a grant to execute a grant agreement in an amount up to that awarded for the proposed project and to sign the grant agreement; and, if awarded a grant, the matching funds in the amount of \$59,820 will be available for this project;
