Park Ridge water department had guest speakers Bill Beattie, Bill Hahn & Chris O'Leary. Bill Beattie discussed Park Ridge Water Department's NJDEP required sampling and notified the board that all analysis is available on NJDEP Water Watch website.

## **Sanitarian's Report**

There was a complaint reported at the Hilton where guests claimed children got burns from the pool. The injury was more of an itch or irritation than a burn. The pool/spa analysis reports that all conform to normal standards.

Acme received a complaint by customer, claims purchased moldy cut fruit. Sanitarian inspected all cut fruit and reviewed complaint with manager.

Horses on overlook Drive had foot problems and were referred for Veterinarian treatment.

The report was approved on a motion by Elaine Metlitz and seconded by Dr. Christine LaPaglia and carried by a roll call vote with all in favor.

## **Registrar's Report**

## **April Water Report:**

April's report regarding coliform levels that were all acceptable was approved on a motion from Dr. Mary Clark seconded by Josephine Higgins and carried.

## **Miscellaneous Discussion**

The flu vaccine program that occurs in October was discussed. The County has revised their policy, and we will be charged only for those vaccines used. The Board of Health agreed that the flu program should be restarted.

Bergen County Animal Control will be invited to a meeting to discuss the type of services they offer as compared to Tyco Animal Control.

A letter from the Board President was submitted to the Mayor and Council recommending a regional approach to halting the sale of tobacco products to those under 21 years of age. Mayor Rendo will discuss this proposal at a future meeting of the Pascack Valley Mayors Association.

John Frey will follow up with the Valley Hospital which is interested in scheduling a health fair at the Tice Center in October.
