“200-1. **Purpose.** This chapter is ordained to control, regulate and license conducting of sales, commonly referred to as “garage sales,” within residential areas of the borough. Such sales are hereby defined as the sale of household merchandise owned by the resident of the premises, such as surplus household and other accessory items.

200-2. **License required; issuance; restrictions.** A. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to conduct any sale, commonly known as a “garage sale,” without first having received a license. B. The Borough Clerk is hereby authorized to issue a license. The license shall be issued for a period not to exceed three (3) consecutive days after the person or persons have made application to the Borough Clerk, setting forth name, address and date of sale. Only two (2) licenses shall be issued within any one-year period for any said location of sale. (Amended 11-8-71 by Ord. No. 71-13; 9-3-75 by Ord. No. 75-11) C. The Mayor and Council is hereby authorized to determine the amount of the fee for the license.

200-3. **Effect on Zoning Ordinance.** It is not the intention of this chapter to change or amend the Zoning Ordinance of the borough.

200-4. **Violations and Penalties.** Any person violating any of the provisions and terms of this chapter shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to a fine of not more than one thousand dollars (\$1000) and/or imprisonment in the county jail for not more than ninety (90) days, in the discretion of the court.
