A note from Dr. Paul Rosenberg from Saddle River, NJ.

Dr. Paul Rosenberg, from Saddle River is the owner and CEO of a medical device facility. As a result of the COVID-19 pandemic, we have converted a portion of our design and manufacturing facility to make disposable face shields for widespread donation as part of the effort to protect first responders and medical professionals. As our staff is limited, I am reaching out to fellow Saddle River residents to request their participation in the assembly and packaging of these devices so that we can get them into the hands of those who need them. Our goal is to produce at least 500 face shields per day and provide them, free of charge, to healthcare workers throughout the USA.

If anyone is interested in helping, we will be setting up a 'socially distanced' workspace in the cafeteria of the Wandell School. We need a total of twelve volunteers for each shift. Students are welcome to join in the effort. Protective gear will be provided if you do not have a mask of your own. Volunteers will be asked to complete the short survey below to ensure the safety of all individuals who will be in the Wandell School.
