
Dear Residents,


The Mayor and Council are pleased to announce they have authorized the most aggressive Municipal Road Paving program to date. This year's program includes 16 roads within the Borough. They include Claire Circle, Burlington Place, West Hill Road, Emery Lane, Anderson Court, Old Farms Road, Shield Drive, Maria Road, Ginny Drive, Sycamore Drive, Fairview Avenue, Sophie Court, Heritage Court, Fox Hollow Court, Amy Court and Michael Street.


Within Woodcliff Lake there are 176 roads; 165 are municipal roads and 11 are County roads. Of the 165 municipal roads, 69 (42%) of the roadways were last paved 18 years ago and 46 (28%) of the roadways were last paved 15-17 years ago. Annual resurfacing of our roads is an important infrastructure initiative.

Woodcliff Lake is part of the Pascack Valley Cooperative Road Paving Program which includes the following municipalities: the Borough of Emerson, the Borough of Old Tappan, the Borough of Paramus, the Township of Rochelle Park, the Township of River Vale, and the Borough of Woodcliff Lake. Work is scheduled to commence in early summer and conclude in late August. Any residential work requiring street openings should be completed prior to repaving. During construction you may not park your vehicles on the street between the hours of 7 am and 7 pm. Additional notice will be provided once the work is scheduled to begin.
